

Here's how our events work:

In each case, we help the organizers custom-design their own program. In order to attract a diverse audience — and thereby inspire a richer discussion — we suggest that events be co-hosted by a group of local programming partners. The centerpiece of each program is our film screening + talkback; individual programs sometimes include panel discussions, live performances and / or receptions. Programs are facilitated by Park Rangers in collaboration with the filmmakers; local Baldwin scholars, educators and artists may be invited to participate as well. All programs are free and open to the public. In terms of internal expenditures, our NEA grant allows the Baldwin Project to offer the film screening, the filmmakers' participation, plus help with event organization, promotion and facilitation, for free — but we do ask the Park and its partners for financial assistance with travel costs whenever possible.
